

ISIC/ITIC

(International Student/Teacher Identity Card)

Studying Abroad? Did you know that your regular GT student ID may not be accepted as proof of student status while you are abroad? ISIC (International Student Identity Card) is internationally recognized as proof of student status and in many countries provides student discounts on airfares and other transportation, accommodation and admission fees to museums, cultural events and concerts. ISIC also provides basic medical and accident insurance for as long as your ISIC is valid. Benefits of ITIC (International Teacher Identity Card) are similar to those of ISIC.



ISIC is valid for one year from the issue date. There is no age limit for purchasing ISIC, but age restrictions may apply to some discounts. A handbook, free to all ISIC/ITIC purchasers, provides detailed information on insurance, emergency assistance, student airfares and discounts in the United States and abroad. You can purchase an ISIC or an ITIC in the Office of International Education (OIE) at Georgia Tech by bringing in or mailing the following items:

1. Proof of student or faculty status (student or faculty ID card or an official transcript). If mailing materials, send a photocopy.
2. One photo (preferably 35mm x 30mm). Photos can be taken at OIE. Cost is \$15 (check or money order) for sheet of 8 photos.
3. Fee \$22, payable by check or money order to the order of Georgia Tech
4. ISIC/ITIC information sheet (available in OIE or at http://www.oie.gatech.edu/sa/forms/appl_isic.pdf)
